

Matthew 8

Vs 1-3

When Jesus came down from the mountainside, large crowds followed Him. A man with leprosy came and knelt before Him and said, "Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean." Jesus reached out His hand and touched the man. "I am willing," He said. "Be clean!" Immediately he was cured of his leprosy.

Vs 5

When Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to Him, asking for help.

Vs 14-15

When Jesus came into Peter's house, He saw Peter's mother-in-law lying in bed with a fever. He touched her hand and the fever left her, and she got up and began to wait on Him.

Vs 16

When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to Him, and He drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick.

Vs 26-27

Jesus replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" Then He got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm. The men were amazed and asked, "What kind of man is this? Even the winds and the waves obey Him!"

Vs 28

When he arrived at the other side in the region of the Gadarenes, two demon-possessed men coming from the tombs met him. They were so violent that no one could pass that way.

9:1-2

Jesus stepped into a boat, crossed over and came to His own town. Some men brought to Him a paralytic, lying on a mat. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Take heart, son; your sins are forgiven."

Vs 9

As Jesus went on from there, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax collector's booth. "Follow me," Jesus told him, and Matthew got up and followed Him.

Vs 16-17

"No one sews a patch of unshrunk cloth on an old garment, for the patch will pull away from the garment, making the tear worse. Neither do men pour new wine into old wineskins. If they do, the skins will burst, the wine will

run out and the wineskins will be ruined. No, they pour new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved."

Vs 18

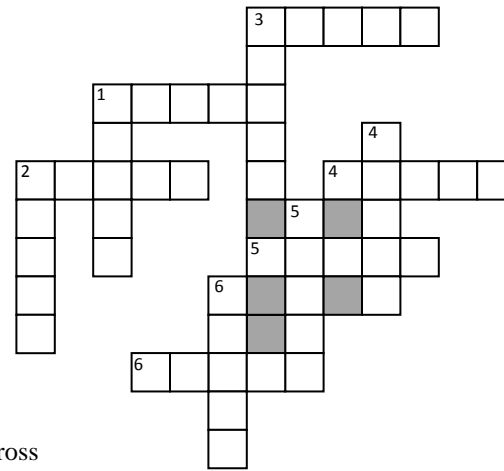
While he was saying this, a ruler came and knelt before him and said, "My daughter has just died. But come and put your hand on her, and she will live." Matthew 9:18
